Bring the power of music into your life and/or your child's life. Music is an important gift you can give to yourself and/or your growing child. Research has shown that music acts as an aid or a tool that enhances learning in many different ways. Music strengthens fine motor skills, dexterity, memory retention, word tracking/reading skills, stress relief and strengthens many other functions of the brain, as well as providing a source of enjoyment and a sense of accomplishment for the child and/or adult.

Ukulele, guitar, song-writing, and voice lessons are taught by **Ron Tish**, professional recording artist, composer, musician and music teacher. Ron graduated from University of Hawai'i with degrees in music and a degree in education. Ron is Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board licensed K-12. Ron has experience teaching and working in both public and private schools and with both adults and children with learning and physical disabilities. As a professional musician and recording artist, Ron spent over 40 years performing, recording, composing, producing and entertaining in Waikiki and on the mainland. Ron has released two albums and has performed with and for many well known and popular entertainers such as Frankie Avalon, Sammy Davis, Helen Reddy, Johnny Paycheck, Steve and Edie Gormet and countless other shows and acts, as well as his own solo act.

Lessons will be scheduled on a weekly basis. Both private or group lessons will be available to adults or children. **(Note: Private lessons are not suggested for younger or beginning students.)** Group lessons @\$20.00 per lesson, and are one half-hour long. Private lessons will be \$30.00, and also are one half-hour in length. A 10% discount applies for a one-time payment at beginning of each semester for all lessons during that semester. **(ask about other special family rates) (Preferred method!) Max 6 students per class.**

Younger and/or beginning students will normally be scheduled to occupy the earliest lesson times. Guitar and advanced classes will occur at the later time slots. Group lesson sessions will contain a maximum of six children. **IMPORTANT!** Additional practice time suggested: 15-20 minutes per day is expected and should be carried out by student to increase proficiency. Private, one-on-one lessons can be arranged for advanced level students.
