LENT A TIME FOR CHANGE

Our observance of Lent began on Ash Wednesday, February 22, a day of fast and abstinence for Catholics. At Mass on Ash Wednesday, Star of the Sea faculty, staff and students received ashes on their foreheads. The imposition of ashes replicates an ancient penitential practice and symbolizes our dependence upon God's mercy and forgiveness.

During Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through March 9 Teachers' In-Service Day the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**, a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics.

The three traditional pillars of Lenten observance are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The Church asks us to surrender ourselves to prayer and to the reading of Scripture, to fasting and to giving alms. The fasting that all do together on Fridays is but a sign of the daily Lenten discipline of individuals and households: fasting for certain periods of time, fasting from certain foods, but also fasting from other things and activities. Likewise, the giving of alms is some effort to share this world egually—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents.
