The safety of your children is most important to MSOS. With this said, we have added one additional item to our school supply list for the upcoming 2020-21 school year.

As part of our Emergency Preparedness Plan (EPP), we are requesting that each student submit a labeled, gallon size, ziplock food bag. These bags will be stored in our gymnasium in the event that a schoolwide gymnasium lockdown is necessary. The contents of the bag are intended to sustain your child for a possible 48 hour shelter-in-place.

The contents of the bag should be non-perishable food items such as granola bars, protein bars, individual crackers/cheese, individual cereal packs. You may also wish to include a small comfort object, change of clothes, or small flashlight.

Unless otherwise indicated, these bags will be returned to your child at the conclusion of the school year. We appreciate your cooperation and certainly do hope that we will never need to use these bags.
