The four candles represent four weeks leading up to Christmas. Three candles are purple and one "joy" is pink. These candles remind us of Jesus, the "Light of the World"*

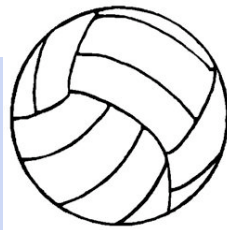
## Girls' Volleyball Season
