Artwork Due September 19, 2022
OPEN TO GRADES 4TH TO 8TH

This year's theme for our yearbook is “How can we follow Jesus’ footsteps?” What are some ways in which we can all use our schools’ SLE’s to be stars in our school, community, our church and in the world and how can this bring us closer to Jesus? Create a Yearbook cover that illustrates “How can we follow Jesus’ footsteps?”

Artwork Requirements:

1. The artwork must span the **front, spine and back cover** of the yearbook, each being 8 ½ x 11”. So to be really successful, create a piece of artwork that is centered on the front cover but has details that wrap around and carry over to the back cover.
2. Illustrate the yearbook theme.
3. If you need paper, see Mrs. Taylor in the art room.
4. Choose from the following mediums: paint, oil pastel, watercolor or crayon, (do not use markers or colored pencils).
5. Ensure your artwork appeals to all of our students from Kindergarten to 8th grade.
6. Do not reproduce/copy someone else’s artwork or artwork from the internet.
7. You can also choose to graphically design the artwork on a computer using Procreate etc. You will need to submit your electronic file as well as well as a hard copy of your artwork.
8. Make sure your artwork does not have any works, numbers, unwanted marks or tears and is not wrinkled. All text will be added by the production company.

Due Date for Art Submission is September 19, 2022
